I, Fikile Mbalula, MP, Minister of Transport, hereby, in terms of regulation 10(7) (b) of the [Regulations](#) issued in terms of the Disaster Management Act, 2002 ([Act No. 57 of 2002](#)) hereby issue directions set out hereunder:

- (1) For the purpose of these directions the following services are declared as essential services:
- (a) Tollgate operators
 - (b) Road emergency operators
 - (c) Employees responsible for safe operation of the roads
 - (d) Rail logistic operators

This Notice shall become effective from the date of publication in the Government Gazette.
