Exemption Regarding the Sale of Electronically Controlled Ventilators

Government Notice R722 of 2020

I, Dr Zwelini Lawrence Mkhize, Minister of Health, under section 3(1A)(b) of the Hazardous Substances Act, 1973 ([Act 15 of 1973](#)), hereby exempt a medical device establishment licensed in terms of section 22C(1)(b) and duly authorised in terms of section 21 of the Medicines and Related Substances Act, 1965 ([Act 101 of 1965](#)), to sell an electronically controlled ventilator (a Group III hazardous substance) for use in the Republic, from the provisions of section 3(1)(b) of the Hazardous Substances Act, 1973 ([Act 15 of 1973](#)).

This exemption shall be effective immediately for a period not exceeding eighteen (18) months from the date of signature of this Notice.
